Save Your Child's Seat Now For Summer Programming

We are gearing up for summer here at Tyson Library, and our students are in for such a fun and fulfilling season. Our theme is All Together Now. Ms. Aly has programs planned to encourage our Summer Explorers to first look inward at themselves then to turn outward into their families, friends and our community.

Our Summer Explorers will meet weekly from mid-June through July. Our preschoolers will be Tuesday mornings, the kindergarteners and first graders will be Tuesday afternoons. On Thursdays we will see our second and third graders in the morning then the fourth, fifth, and sixth graders in the afternoon. Access Millions Of Digital Resources With Your Library Card - For Free!

Download The Libby App Today



As an Evergreen Indiana library, Tyson Library has access to millions of shared resources that are all available at no cost to our patrons.

Many of these resources are accessible through the free mobile app Libby. Libby helps readers access digital books, also known as ebooks, and audiobooks.

Libby users can also borrow digital magazines to read on the go.



Setting up your account on the app only takes a few simple steps!

1. Download or open Libby on your device
2. In Libby, follow the prompts to find your library and sign in with your library card. Enter the full card number on the back of your library card and the last 4 digits of your phone number as your PIN.
3. Browse your library's catalog and borrow a title.
4. Borrowed titles appear on your Shelf and download the app automatically when you're connected to Wi-Fi, so you can read them when you are offline.

You can have up to 10 ebooks, 10 audiobooks, and 10 magazines borrowed at a time. You can also have as many as 10 holds placed at a time.

If you would like help downloading and setting up the Libby app on your device, please call ahead and set a time for a Tyson Library staff member to work with you.
