# Tyson Library Transitioning to Online Registrations for All Programming in January

Tyson Library is moving to a fully online registration system for programming and events starting in January. We're thrilled to provide this convenience for our patrons of all ages!

Having used online registration for adult programs for several years, many of our patrons should already be familiar with the sign-up process. The main changes you might notice are different questions on the forms, tailored to the specific program they are registering for. For instance, we will inquire about food allergies for events involving food and beverages.

Parents and caregivers can register their children for upcoming programs by visiting the calendar on our website (www.tysonlibrary.org/events). From the calendar, simply select the program your child is interested in, and you will see an option to "Register" or "Join Waiting List" if applicable.



To the left is what the register option looks like on our new site once you've clicked on your desired program.

Complete every field in the form that appears after you click on Register. Additionally, please fill out a separate form for each child wishing to enroll.

For our monthly and bi-monthly afterschool programs, registering your child for just one session will secure their spot for the entire semester. The fall semester runs from September to December, while the spring semester is from January to April.
