How to Get a Library Card from Tyson Library

Tyson Library is part of the Evergreen Indiana Library Consortium. This membership gives our patrons free access to millions of books and other resources too!

All you need to get your library card is a valid photo ID and a secondary proof of residence (a utility bill, for example). Tyson Library can only issue cards to those who live in Johnson, Brown, Shelby, or Otter Creek township in Ripley County.

Any adult staff member can register you for a free library card. And no appointment is necessary, just come in during



our regular hours of operation: Monday through Friday from 10 a.m. to 6 p.m. or Saturdays from 10 a.m. to 3 p.m.

After you are signed up, you can check items out from our local collection or place holds on items from other libraries in the consortium. Any holds you place on books from other libraries will be delivered to Tyson Library for you to pick up.

Your library card also gives you access to the consortium's collection of e-books and digital audiobooks through the Libby app, which is free to download to your phone or tablet.
